Parliament's expectations for the Copenhagen climate change summit in December include an ambitious and legally binding agreement that will require emission reduction targets for developed and developing countries as well as funding commitments and sanctions for non-compliance. EU government leaders must demonstrate political leadership to make a success of the summit, say MEPs in a resolution adopted on Wednesday. Future generations might not be able to control climate change if global action is further delayed.

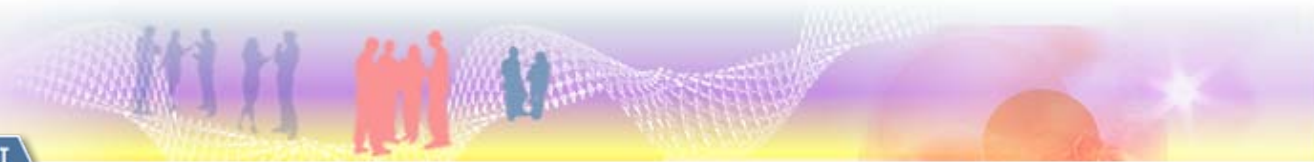
