Bureau Declaration

At its meeting, under the Italian Presidency, on 3 March 2011, the Bureau of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Union for the Mediterranean:

- expresses its wholehearted solidarity with the aspirations to freedom of the peoples of the Mediterranean region, reaffirming the universal value of democracy which is embodied in the sovereignty of the people as the source from which political institutions derive their legitimacy and expresses its heartfelt condolences for the innocent victims of the recent events in the Mediterranean region;
- firmly condemns recourse to violence and any other forms of repression of protest movements in Libya, and joins in the initiatives taken by the United Nations, the Arab League and the European Union to achieve the aspirations of the Libyan people to freedom, democracy and social justice;
- furthermore expresses its concern for the deterioration of the humanitarian crisis at the borders of the North African country and, in welcoming the prompt beginning of humanitarian initiatives by international organisations and a number of governments in favour of the peoples and foreign workers, urges that efforts be multiplied with a view to relieving the hardships and sufferings of the stricken populations;
- supports the political processes of democratic development which have begun in the region, so that they can take place in total compliance with the principles of the rule

of law, through dialogue between all the political and social forces, and with the free dissemination of information, looking ahead to future and well-prepared elections;

urges that direct negotiations for peace in the Middle East will resume as soon as

possible in a climate of mutual trust, based on the principle of two States living side-

by-side in peace and security, guaranteeing the continuity of the agreements signed;

recalling that the Parliamentary Assembly of the UfM is the representative

dimension of the UfM and the only UfM institution that has worked without

solution of continuity, strongly appeals to the UfM governments to demonstrate

their ability to measure up to this historic challenge and to relaunch the role of the

UfM as a forum for global partnership between the northern and southern shores;

requests that the Summit of Heads of State and Government that has been postponed

several times already be convened as soon as possible; recommends that the

activities of the UfM be intensified to achieve greater social and economic

integration in the region, so as to raise the well-being of the people and notably

youth employment; calls for the enhancement of the relations between civil societies

as an underlying dimension of the partnership;

expects that the extraordinary meeting of the European Council due to take place on

Friday 11 March will give new impetus to the neighbourhood policy in the

Mediterranean region through concrete orientations for policy action; requests that

appropriate tools be implemented to accompany democratic processes as was the

case in other geographical areas in the past;

• emphasises the role of the Parliaments, so that all the governments place themselves

at the service of their citizens and peoples, and the general interests, fostering

resource-sharing, combating corruption, and achieving the aspirations of peoples to

democracy.
